\*Park in the lot off of Gentry Drive, closer to Nixon. You will go down some steps then a gravel path next to the Rollingwood City Hall/Police Station.


There is no street parking allowed along Nixon Drive. The Pavillion is in the lower section of the park, NOT near the baseball fields.\*


