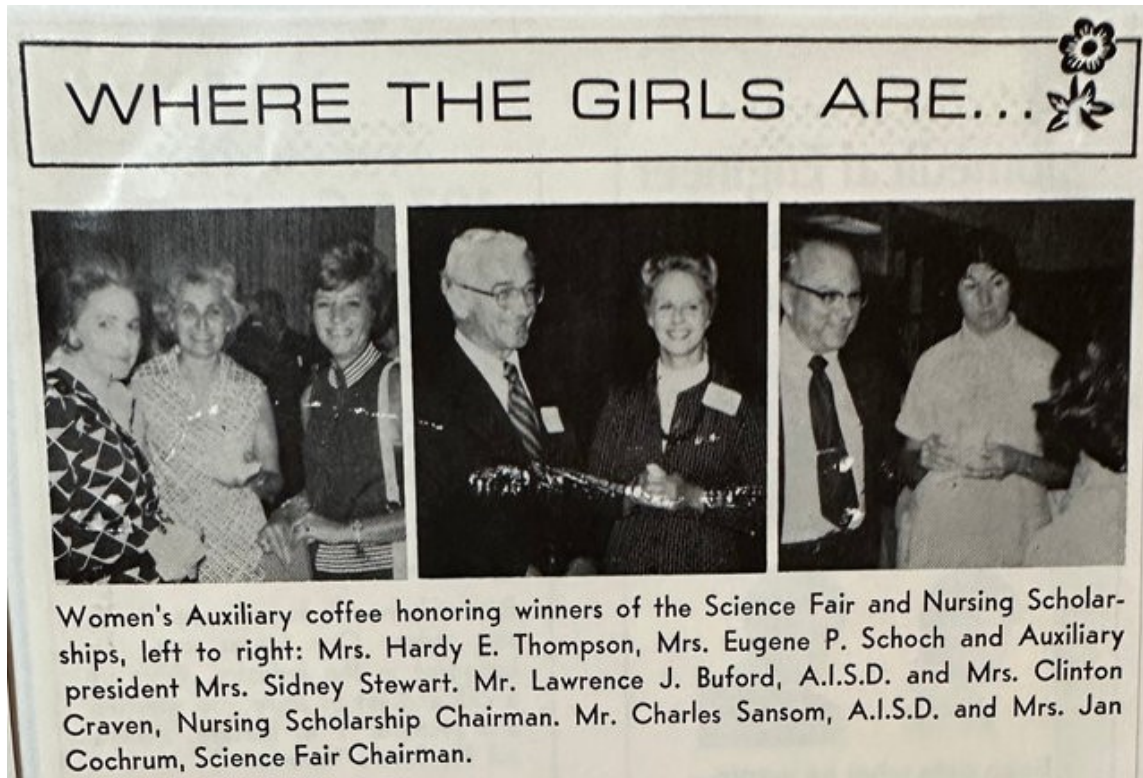

TCMA: Celebrating a Century of Supporting Healthcare



In 1955 the TCMA began a partnership with the Austin ISD to support an area-wide Austin high school Science Fair. Two years later, the Science Fair became a significant focus for members of the Auxiliary, making it the "first large money raising project," raising \$420 to send the top two Austin Science Fair winners to the National Science Fair in Los Angeles. Over the following decades the Alliance supported the top winners by sending them to national and international competitions. Today, nearly 70 years later, the TCMA proudly supports the Science Fair.

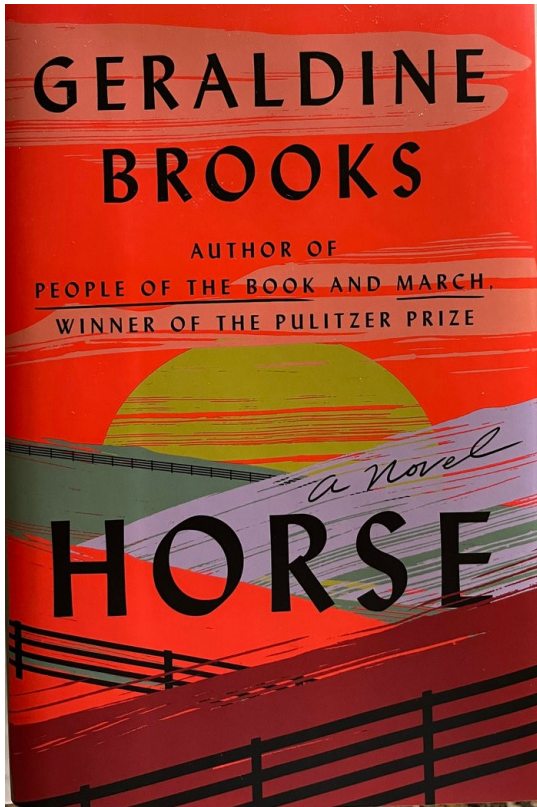
